- Submit a complete application to members@plida.org. Application Form and Conflict of Interest Form need to be typed and submitted electronically in a Word Document format
- Submit Resume of experience related to identified position sought
- Include Employer Support Letter with their application

- Contribute to and attend quarterly board meetings (via teleconference)
- Oversee project work of committees; including monthly meetings and additional designated hours
- Attend PLIDA Board Orientation Retreat (date and place to be determined)
